Rules and regulations

- \blacktriangle Young adults are those aged between 18 28, inclusive.
- Affected people can be accompanied by their partner or a sibling.
- A maximum of four young adults per country can attend.

A

- A co-ordinating person for the young adults is to be designated who will be the contact person for the Co-ordinating Committee and attends the pre-meeting to organise the next EMSN meeting at the expense of the EMSN.
- A They are to work out their proposal for guidelines for the Young Adults Group.
- A The co-ordinators deal with differences and problems arising during their meeting.
- A The programme is aimed at young adults discussing their problems of daily life. They are expected to report back to the EMSN Co-ordinating Committee and to the delegates.
- A They develop their own programme and, in addition, they are given set topics to discuss and report on.
- A Offers from young adults to take on tasks in the EMSN are a welcome support for the Coordinating Committee and should be encouraged.
- The decision for financial support of their meeting, is to be made from year to year.
- We respect their wish to remain anonymous. Their names will not appear anywhere without their express permission, except in the list of participants of the EMSN meeting.
